

# FAMILY FLU CLINICS

Open to anyone age 4 and older.

Convenient for families and working people, flu vaccination clinics will be held in the towns of Berlin, Newington, Rocky Hill, and Wethersfield by the Central Connecticut Health District. If you or your family members have not been immunized for seasonal flu yet this season, now is the optimal time to do so. No residency requirements.

The Health District offers 3 types of vaccination; nasal spray vaccine (available to any healthy person age 4 through 49), injectable and preservative-free injectable.
